

2017 CLUB DRESS REGULATIONS

The following are **NOT** acceptable within the Club:

- 1. Dirty / soiled clothing.
- 2. Slashed, ripped or frayed clothing except when such is part of the design.
- 3. Brief shorts that may be considered offensive (with or without pockets), bike riding style shorts, leotards or board shorts.
- 4. Singlets, muscle shirts, tank tops, see-through blouses, midriff tops or crop tops.
- 5. Clothing with political or obscene slogans or pictures.
- 6. Tracksuit pants and work clothing (e.g. overalls) **not permitted after 8pm** (Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays).
- 7. Scuffs, slippers or any footwear which is deemed inappropriate by management.
- 8. Rubber thongs **not permitted after 6.30pm**.
- 9. Hats, scarves, bandanas or other headwear (except for religious, medical or cultural purposes).
- 10. Studded belts.
- 11. School uniforms in restricted areas.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any patron who, in its opinion, is not suitably attired.
